Emergency Management Educational Resources and Tools

When: Available to RISE participating communities throughout RISE 4.0.

What/Why: HAPevolve's EM Track has 9 main video modules highlighting each aspect of the emergency management cycle, with 10+ additional in-depth modules on hazard plans, as well as tools, such as hazard vulnerability assessments, to download and use in your facility. These modules provide you with the basic knowledge you need to have an effective emergency management program! Participants will also get access to HAPevolve's online Emergency Management Resource Directory for Pennsylvania.

Time Commitment: Self-paced and can be viewed at any point throughout RISE 4.0.



Emergency Management Tabletop (TTX) Tuesdays **Exercises**

When: Monthly starting August 2025 - May 2026, the THIRD Tuesday of the month, from 11AM-1PM, with first tabletop on August 19, 2025. You will receive invite for the series. Topics are subject to change.

What/Why: The RISE 4.0 Emergency Preparedness track will feature a series of virtual TTX each month called Tabletop Tuesdays. Our emergency managers will test facility's plans and their ability to prepare, respond, and recover from a variety of different hazards and scenarios.

Time Commitment: There will be a total of 10 (2-hour) virtual, tabletop exercises. Participants will have an opportunity to register for exercises that fit their schedule.

At the end of the exercises, participants will submit attendance and will receive a certificate of attendance to keep for their records for their yearly requirements.

Emergency Preparedness Program (EPP)

What/Why: The Emergency Preparedness Program (EPP), a 12-month program, is designed to give healthcare providers access to training, education, and expertise that supports them in improving their emergency preparedness. We recognize that preparedness is a journey, not a destination, and that every organization is unique. The program contains elements that every facility should do on an annual basis, while still retaining the ability to customize to meet the unique needs of every organization.



Portable Response Emergency Plan (PREP)

What/Why: PREP is a web-based mobile app that health care organizations use to host their emergency operations plans, facility-specific files and information that all staff members can quickly access. PREP improves communication, comprehension, and reaction times during an emergency.



Educational Escape Rooms

What/Why: HAPevolve gamified educational escape room trainings provide a fun, hands-on, and cooperative learning environment to help staff comprehend, retain and recall safety information and protocol. Our escape rooms gather small teams within your facility to work together to solve puzzles, answer questions, and race against the clock to compete and ultimately "escape" the challenge.
